AUDIT EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Pappas Farms 1 has approximately 1,706 acres of conventional cantaloupes, watermelons, honeydew and corn. Planting began in February, with harvest starting in June and expected to conclude by mid-October. No field workers were observed during this audit. The growing areas are surrounded by agricultural land, roads, Pappas Facility and Pappas main yard. Only synthetic fertilizers are applied at this farm. Irrigation and fertigation are conducted through a drip system using wells or canal water. This audit covered a group of three ranches, four harvest crews, and one packinghouse operating under the same Food Safety Management System (FSMS).
